DAY 1 / MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 16 / ARRIVAL IN TURIN

- Arrival at Turin Airport (transfers from Milan can be arranged at extra cost)
- Transfer from Turin Airport to the hotel
- Welcome Reception and Dinner

- Visit to the former office of Primo Levi or the Primo Levi Center

- Afternoon transfer to Florence
- Check-in at the villa near Florence
- Shabbat Dinner at the villa
- Villa Olmi

- Return to Parma in the late afternoon

- Visit the grave of Giorgio Bassani at the Ferrara Jewish Cemetery
- Walk in the Ghetto to the National Museum of Judaism and the Shoah
- Lunch in Ferrara
- Visit the grave of Rabbi Meir Katzenellenbogen at Padua's Historic Cemetery
- Visit Padua's Jewish Museum
- Check in at the villa in the late afternoon

- Villa Barbarich

PAYMENT:

To sign up for the tour, each traveler must complete a reservation form. Upon receipt of the reservation, YIVO will issue an invoice. The first installment (50%) is due upon registration, and the second and final installment is due no later than May 1st.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND:

For all cancellations, we will refund payment less the following cancellation fees:

CHANGES:

Participants requiring individual travel arrangements in conjunction with this tour must inform the Tour Operator as early as possible. Individual arrangements can be made pre- or post-tour. For any change made 90 days or less prior to the tour, a service fee of \$100 per person will be charged. All expenses involved with individual travel arrangements will be the responsibility of the individual traveler.

MEALS:

Breakfasts are served buffet-style at the hotels. Other meals are served at restaurants or at the hotels and are based upon set menus reflecting local traditions. However, alternatives are provided for travelers requiring special meals, such as vegetarian or fish options. Lunches will vary according to the time and the place. Alcoholic beverages are not included.



AIRPORT TRANSFERS:

Momentum Tours & Travel offers complimentary transfers on the listed arrival and departure dates (September 16 in Turin and September 29 in Venice). Individual transfers from Milan Malpensa Airport can be arranged at an extra cost. For pre-tour arrivals or post-tour departures, individual transfers, hotels, or other services can be arranged upon request and must be paid directly to Momentum Tours & Travel by the individual travelers.

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

PASSPORT AND VISA:

Visas for U.S. citizens are not required for this departure. However, travelers from other countries should check if visas are required. Please ask if in doubt. In addition, each traveler must possess a passport, valid for at least 6 months after the tour has been completed.

COVID AND TRAVEL:

There are no longer Covid-related restrictions for travelers. Borders are open, and masks are not required. We continue to recommend that travelers be vaccinated and boosted.
